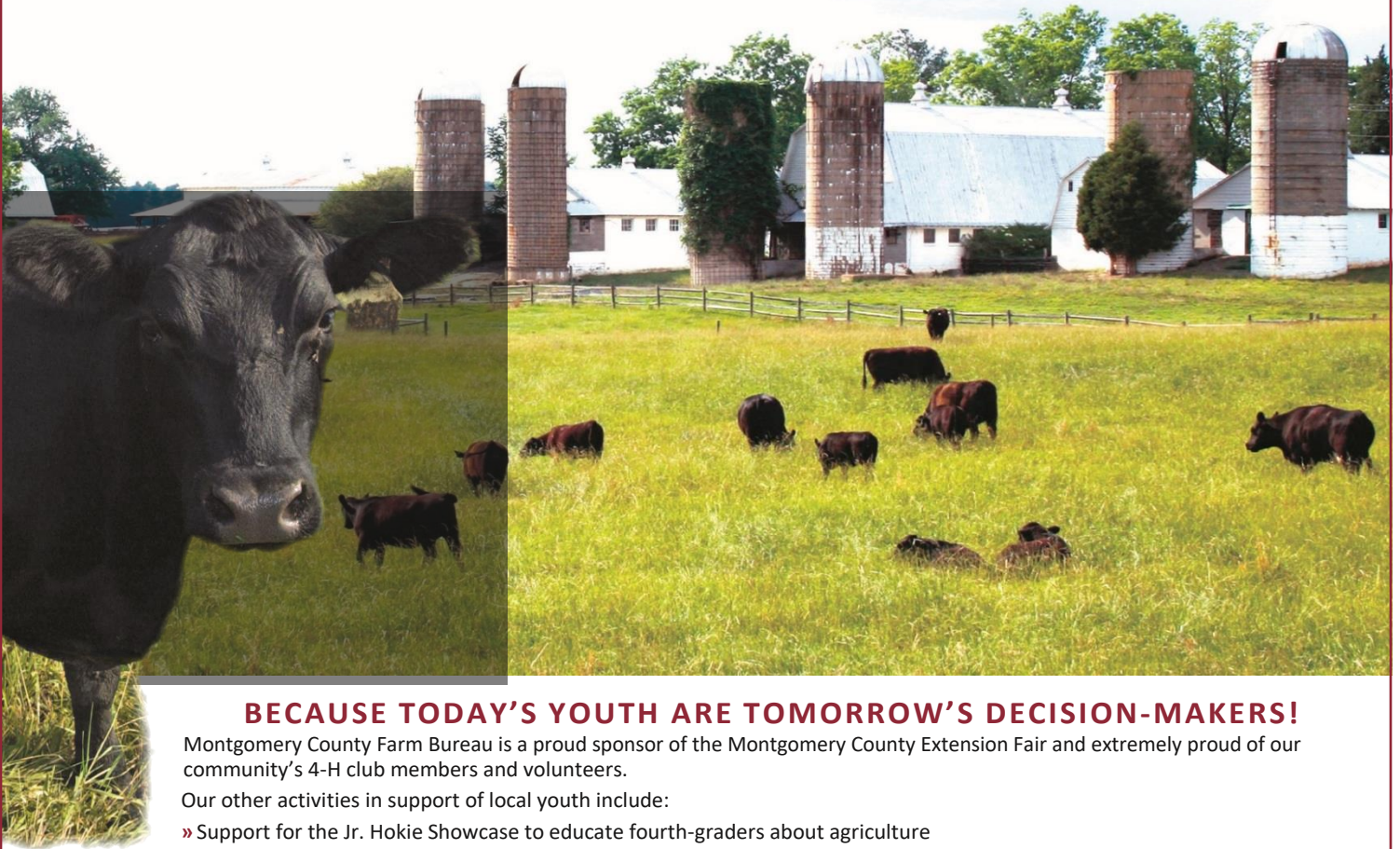

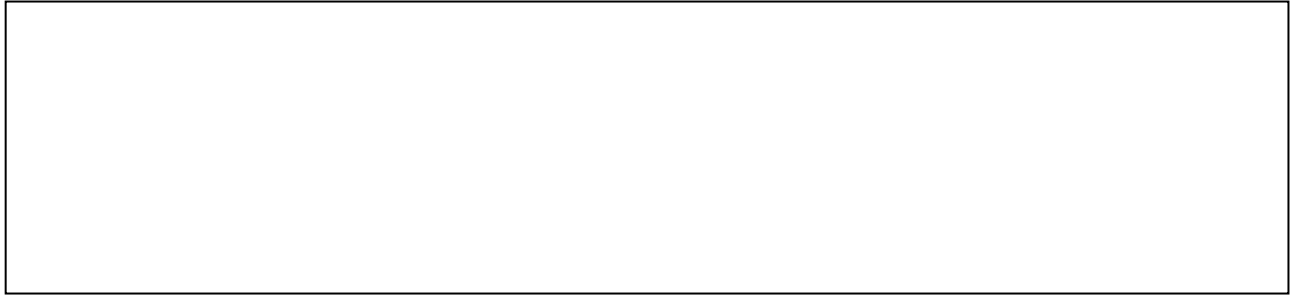

Montgomery County Extension Fair Map of Fair Locations



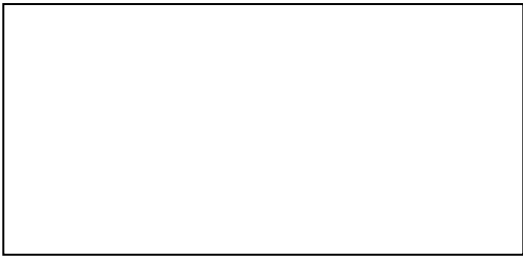

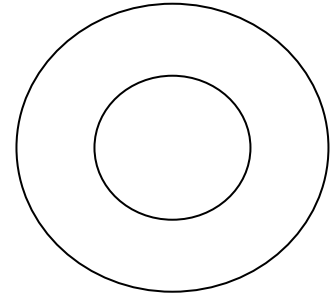
