Glucose Gel	Increase blood sugar level	
Glucose Tablets	Increase blood sugar level	
Caladryl Lotion	Soothe itching from bug bites, stings, and irritation	Calamine Lotion
Diphenhydramine	Antihistimine - used for allergic reactions	Benadryl
Naphazoline Hydrochloride with Saline and/or Glycerin	Eye allergy drops	Clear Eyes, Visine
Ear Drying Drops (Isopropyl Acohol & Glycerin)	Used to remove water from ear	Swim Ear
Cough Drops	Soothe sore throat and reduce coughing	Halls
Acetaminophen & Dexamethorphan (Daytime)	Decongestant and pain relief	Dayquil
Acetaminophen & Dexamethorphan (Nighttime)	Decongestant and pain relief	Nyquil
Suphedrine	Decongestant	Sudafed
Phenylprhine PE	Decongestant	Sudafed PE
Ibuprofen	Pain relief	Motrin, Advil
Acetaminophen	Pain relief	Tylenol
Orasol Gel	Oral pain relief	Orajel
Bismuth Subsalicylate	Used to soothe stomach issues	Pepto Bismol
Triple Anitbiotic Ointment	Prevents infection	Neosporin
Hydrocortizone Cream	Soothe itching from irritation or rash	Cortizone
Calcium Carbonate	Used to soothe stomach issues	Tums
Magnesium Hydroxide	Used to soothe stomach issues	Milk of Magnesia
Loperamide HCl	Anti-diarrheal	Immodium
T-Tussin DM	Decongestant and cough suppressant	Robitussin
